Phyllis:

I am finally getting caught up on our reporting for the Lupin site. Attached are individual monthly reports for the period January to June, 2009 as well as the covering letter for the 2008 annual report. The annual report is too large to e-mail, so I have sent a hard copy and digital copy on CD ROM to you via courier. I have also sent a CD to Dave for his use directly.

Also, to update you on activities on the Lupin site. We have mobilized two people to the site to commence this season's care and maintenance activities. They flew in on Monday, June 30th and we expect to have a continuous presence on site until approximately September 15th, weather permitting. They will initially stay in John Franklin's hunting camp on the south shore of Contwoyto Lake, which is actually off the property until they can have the Mine Manager's house serviced and habitable, which should be in approximately one week's time. We expect to haul water by truck to a holding tank outside the cabin for domestic water and to dispose of grey water in a similar manner in the dump pit at the Sewage Lakes. For sanitary waste, we expect to use a Pacto or some other privy system. The camp incinerator will be placed back in to service for the incineration of solid wastes.

Water management at the TCF this year is expected to include a discharge from Pond 2 to the environment and a transfer of water from Cell 4 to Pond 1 and from Pond 1 to Pond 2. The Sewage Lakes system will also be discharged to the environment during the summer. We expect to commence discharge around July 15th contingent on the water quality being acceptable for release.
