Phyllis, a crew of two persons were on site for 5 days from June 29th and 30th, 2009. They were accommodated in the trapper's cabin located on the south shore of Contwoyto Lake to the north of the mine/mill complex. Domestic water was drawn from Contwoyto Lake and carried in pails to the camp for dishwashing. Dish water and sanitary waste was placed in a pit privy near the cabin. The total water use is estimated to be 2 days x 100 L per person per day = 400 L or 0.4 m³.
