MONTHLY REPORT FOR JULY, 2009

LUPIN MINE - LICENSE 2AM-LUP0914

A three to five person crew was on site throughout the month of July conducting care and maintenance work at the Lupin site. They were housed in the Guest House on the mine site. Domestic water was provided to the house by hauling water from Contwoyto Lake by truck. Greywater disposal was effected via a leaching pit excavated adjacent to the house. Sanitary waste disposal was effected via a privy with human waste and domestic garbage being incinerated. The consumption of water from Contwoyto Lake was 40,500 Litres (40.5 m³) for domestic use only. The results of the chemical analyses for the raw water sample from Contwoyto Lake at Monitoring Point LUP-01 are attached for reference.

There was no discharge from either the Sewage Lakes System (Monitoring Point LUP-14) or the Tailings Containment Facility Pond 2 (LUP-10). Discharges are expected to commence in August from these facilities.
