Melissa:

All the information you are looking for will be reported in the monthly report to the NWB, which I will have out shortly.

In the interim, attached are the lab results from Pond 2, which is Station LUP-10 and for Station LUP-14, the Sewage Lakes discharge point. The results for Pond 2 cover the time period from August 26 to 31st, which is the first week of discharge. Samples are sent from the mine on a weekly basis. The last shipment was on Monday, September 7th, so the results are not in yet. I expect to have the certificates in either today or Monday. I will forward them once I have reviewed them.

The results for the Lower Sewage Lake at Monitoring Point LUP-14 are from a sample collected on August 17th. The monitoring frequency for LUP-14 is once per month; therefore, the next sample will be collected on Monday, September 14th.

In August 440,297 m³ of effluent was discharged from the TCF Pond 2 at Monitoring Point LUP-10 and 188,500 m³ was discharged from the Lower Sewage Lake at Monitoring Point LUP-14. For the week of September 1-7, 492,319 m³ was discharged from Pond 2 at LUP-10 and 21,678 m³ was discharged from the Lower Sewage Lake at LUP-14.
