Activities on site during the month of January primarily included site maintenance activities that support drilling. Infill core drilling did occur on the Lupin mineralized structure (Jan 24-31). We had 366 person days for the month of January, with up to 18 people on site. Accommodation arrangements remain unchanged from December.

Domestic water use for the month was estimated to be 95,664 Litres (95.7  $\,\mathrm{m}^3$ ), drawn from Contwoyto Lake. In addition, 30  $\,\mathrm{m}^3$  per day of water was used to support drilling. Approximately 90,881 L (90.9  $\,\mathrm{m}^3$ ) of sewage was produced and discharged to the upper sewage lagoon. Solid and drilling waste management remain unchanged from December. There were no discharges to the environment.
