Activities on site during the month of November involved site maintenance only. There were 556 person days for the month of November, with up to 25 people on site. Accommodation arrangements remain unchanged from that of October.

Domestic water use for the month was estimated to be $130,130 \text{ L} (130 \text{ m}^3)$, drawn from Contwoyto Lake. Approximately $123,623 \text{ L} (123.6 \text{ m}^3)$ of sewage was produced and discharged to the upper sewage lake.

Domestic waste generated during the month of November was incinerated on-site each day. There were one mega bag of recyclable beverage containers, one drum of oil rags/ pads, one drum of incinerator ash, three drums scrap steel, one waste battery, and twenty-seven drums of oil contaminated soil fuel that were sent to approved facilities in Yellowknife, NT for disposal.
