**Lupin Mine, Nunavut, License Number 2AM-LUP0914**


Activities on site during the month of January involved care and maintenance only. There were 401 person days for the month of January, with up to 17 people on site. Accommodation arrangements remain unchanged from that of December.

Domestic water use for the month was estimated to be 90,900 L (90.9 m<sup>3</sup>), drawn from Contwoyto Lake. Approximately 86,451 L (86.5 m<sup>3</sup>) of sewage was produced and discharged to the upper sewage lake.

Domestic waste generated during the month of January was incinerated on-site each day. There were 2 mega bags plastics, 9 mega bags of miscellaneous solid waste (old carpet, plastics, debris, etc from office restorations), 2 bags of expired first-aid supplies, and 5 bags of recyclable beverage containers that were sent to an approved facility in Yellowknife, NT for recycling and/or disposal.
