Meadowbank Project Certificate No.004/Meadowbank Water License 2AM-MEA0815 - Proposed Fuel Storage Facility Expansion

I am responding to the request made by Stéphane Robert of Agnico-Eagle Mines Ltd. on a July 30, 2009 letter to expand the fuel tank farm in Baker Lake, Nunavut to increase its storage facilities from 40ML to 60ML of Jet A fuel that is a component to the Meadowbank Project and conformity to the Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan (KRLUP).

In the present circumstance, the Commission does not need to review for conformity the change to the project noted above in connection to condition 27 and condition 42 of the P.C, and to the items listed in the current Nunavut Water License. All the conformity requirements to which the proponent agreed to in relation to the Meadowbank Project are still in effect and must be incorporated, or otherwise ensure that they are met in the terms and conditions of any authorizations issued.
