**Re: Invitation to Industrial Type “A” Water Licence Holders to Meet NWB New Technical Staff on January 17, 2018**

On behalf of the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) I would like to extend an invitation to all holders of Type “A” Water Licences issued by the NWB to authorize the use of water and deposit of wastes associated with Mining Undertakings to meet the NWB’s new technical staff on January 17, 2018 when the Board’s new staff will be in Edmonton doing orientation training. In the interests of supporting a successful and seamless transition from the NWB’s previous technical advisors responsible for these Type “A” Licences to the NWB’s new technical staff, the NWB is extending this invitation to existing licensees. The Board has allocated a 2-hour block to each licensee who wishes to meet the NWB’s new staff and to provide, either in person or via teleconference, a brief background presentation to the staff to familiarize them with the licensee’s undertaking, the status of the current Type “A” Licence and/or any future modifications, changes or amendments. As with a site visit, the Board notes that the purpose of these sessions is limited to providing new staff with a **general orientation** to the Mining Undertakings governed by Type “A” Licences and there will be no substantive discussion of any issues that are before the NWB for decision-making, nor will the NWB’s Board Members (who are the decision-makers for all files) be present during these background sessions.
