Given that the NIRB monitoring program focuses on compliance and effects monitoring, the NIRB is also requesting that Parties provide comments and/or information on the following:

## 1) Effects Monitoring

- a. Whether the conclusions reached by AEM in the 2008 Annual Report are valid;
- b. Any areas of significance requiring further studies; and
- c. Changes to the monitoring program which may be required.

## 2) Compliance Monitoring

- a. Any instances of non-compliance with respect to any licences, permits, or authorizations that have been issued; and
- b. Whether any inspections were completed during the 2008 reporting period, and if so, a summary of the results of those inspections.
