## Dear Parties:

On August 20, 2012 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) received Agnico-Eagle Mines Ltd.'s (AEM) *Meadowbank Gold Project 2011 Annual Report*. In accordance with Appendix D annexed to the Meadowbank Gold Mine Project Certificate [No. 004] issued by the NIRB in December 2006, AEM is required to report annually to the NIRB on activities undertaken with respect to the Meadowbank Project.

The NIRB requests that interested parties review the *Meadowbank Gold Project 2011 Annual Report* and provide comments with respect to their jurisdiction and/or area of expertise by **September 21, 2012**. The NIRB is also requesting that Parties provide comments and/or information with respect to the following:

## 1) Compliance Monitoring

- a. How the authorizing agency has incorporated the terms and conditions from the Project Certificate into their permits, certificates, licences or other government approvals, where applicable;
- b. A summary of any inspections conducted during the 2011 reporting period, and the results of these inspections; and
- c. A summary of AEM's compliance status with regard to authorizations that have been issued for the Project.

## 2) Effects monitoring

- a. Whether the conclusions reached by AEM in the 2011 Annual Report are valid;
- b. Any areas of significance requiring further studies; and
- c. Changes to the monitoring program which may be required.
