Re: Receipt of Addendum to the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the Vault Pit Expansion Amendment Proposal for the Meadowbank Gold Mine Project

## Dear Stéphane Robert:

On July 15, 2015 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd.'s (AEM or Proponent) addendum to the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the Meadowbank Gold Project. The Addendum to the FEIS is to support the necessary technical review of the Vault Pit Expansion project as proposed by AEM and as part of the NIRB's reconsideration of Project Certificate No. 004 pursuant to Section 12.8.2(b) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement.

The Board has commenced an internal review of the Addendum to the Final EIS to determine whether this document conforms to the previously issued NIRB's EIS Guidelines<sup>1</sup>. This conformity review is meant to be a presence or absence analysis only rather than an evaluation of the quality of the information presented; although the NIRB may point out significant deficiencies encountered.

The NIRB anticipates that its internal conformity review of the Addendum to the Final EIS will take approximately 15 days to complete and if the addendum is deemed to be satisfactory (positive conformity determination), the NIRB will distribute the Addendum to the public and commence the technical review period. The technical review period will provide interested parties with an opportunity to analyze the adequacy and quality of the information presented within the Addendum to the Final EIS and to provide the NIRB with their technical review comments and final written submissions.
