Pursuant to Article 12, Sections 12.5.12 and 12.8.3 of the *Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada (Nunavut Agreement)*, and s. 112(10) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, S.C. 2013, c. 14 (*NuPPAA*), the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) is pleased to issue the enclosed amended Project Certificate No. 004 (Amendment 3) for the Meadowbank Gold Mine Project (NIRB File No. 03MN107) to Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle).
