Subject: Processing of Application for a Paragraph 35(2)(b) Fisheries Act Authorization is Resumed

Further to our correspondence of August 15, 2014, the Fisheries Protection Program (the Program) of Fisheries and Oceans Canada is notifying you that the processing of your application for a Paragraph 35(2)(b) *Fisheries Act* authorization has resumed on July 27, 2016 upon confirmation of a letter of acceptance from the Minister of Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) to the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) to allow the project to proceed subject to Project Certificate No.004 Terms and Conditions.

The Program will inform you by October 27, 2016 of the decision to issue the authorization or inform you of its refusal to do so.
