Apologies for the delay in responding.

Information submitted by AEM on August 3rd in response to DFO IRs 1-4 provides clarifications, and DFO is comfortable with the full technical review proceeding.

DFO does note that AEM's response to DFO-IR2 does indicate that proposed water use has the potential to exceed authorised volumes in the existing licence 2AM-WTP1826 in some cases (e.g. dust suppression). DFO is confident the technical review process will help clarify if existing authorised volumes are adequate, as stated by AEM in the Water Licence Main Application Document.

We look forward to receiving the technical review schedule.
