WATER LICENICE INICRECTION ECONA

SECTION 1 Comments (s.__) Non-Compliance with Act or Licence (s.__) Action Required (s.__)

Between March 21 and March 22, 2023, Resource Management Officer Kyle Amsel (Inspector) of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada conducted an inspection of Water Licence 2AM-MEA1530 (Licence). The licence is issued to Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Licensee) for the use of waters and deposit of wastes in support of a mining undertaking (Undertaking).

Accompanying the Inspector was Environment Coordinator, Samuel Tapp. The aforementioned is here on referred to as representative. Also accompanying the Inspector was Resource Management Officer Joseph Monteith.

Preliminary Information

The primary focus of this inspection is snow management in and around the area of operations, and compliance with Part J of the Licence.

Observations

- 1. Water usage as of March 22, 2023 is 160,134m³ at ST-1, Third Portage Lake water intake.
- 2. Snow Management
 - a. Signage has been installed at snow dumps near the mill to alert operators not to dump snow (Photo 1)
 - b. Snow from around mill is brought to the Stormwater management pond snow dump. (Photo 2)
 - c. No other snow management concerns were noted during the inspection.
- 3. Freshwater barge
 - a. Signage is installed satisfying Part B Item 10 of the Licence. (Photo 3)
 - b. Water volume is metered at the mill.
- 4. Incinerator
 - a. Representative states the incinerator has not been operated to dispose of household burnable wastes since an exceedance event.
 - b. Currently household wastes are being backhauled. In 2022 backhauled wastes were taken to GFL Environmental-Matrec Champlain, a sorting center in Quebec.
 - c. Representative states the Licensee intends to backhaul household wastes again in 2023.
- 5. Spill 2023-042
 - a. The spill area was inspected.
 - b. Representative stated the spill area reports to Pit E. Field observations by the Inspector supports this.
 - c. Tailings are presently being deposited into Pit E.
 - d. No spill material is present, however this spill will receive final inspection during summer months.
- 6. Sewage from the Marshalling Facility near Baker Lake is trucked to Meadowbank for processing.
- 7. Laydown near N65^o 1' 15.1" W96^o 2' 30.0" near East dike (Photo 4)
 - a. This area is noted by the inspector to contain pieces of equipment, remnants of vehicles, unknown structures and other assorted items.
 - b. The items in the area appear to have no functional use to the Inspector.
- 8. Representative provided the following information regarding pieces of infrastructure which no longer appear to be used:
 - a. The Emulsion Plant no longer has explosive mixing equipment inside, but is now used as heated storage and heated maintenance area.
 - b. North Cell Tailings Storage Facility-Use discontinued in August 2021, however the Licensee intends to deposit there again in 2024.
 - c. South Cell Tailings Storage Facility-Use discontinued in May 2019, however the Licensee intends to deposit there again summer of 2023.
 - d. Goose Pit-Use discontinued in August 2020, there are no intentions to revisit this location.






