Leo arrived in Baker Lake on the 8:30 evening flight, on 17<sup>th</sup> August 2009. He is taken to the Agnico-Eagle office in Baker Lake. He will be staying overnight at the Agnico – Eagle Guest House.

On Tuesday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, Al Farrell of NTCL briefed him when he will be going on the barge. He will be transferred to the barge on 19<sup>th</sup> of August. Al stated that he will get him to the barge. At the office he is given a blue Safety Hat, florescent orange Safety Vest and a Life Jacket for him to wear while on the barge.

### 19 August 2009.

He left Baker Lake on the Barge as per Al Farrell of NTCL. The barge left about 4:30 AM. Told him drop by at the office when back in Baker Lake.

#### 20 August 2009.

While on transit, just before the Channel saw mainly water fowl and Sea Gulls. On the South Channel saw a seal in the water, routine sighting, no problem with seal. Past the Channel saw scattered herds of Caribou by sight and with binoculars. Caribou seen were from around South Channel to Kagvik area (St. Clair Falls). Water fowl and Sea Gull sightings common. Seal seen just one in the Channel area.

#### 21 August 2009

Barge still on transit.

Mainly saw caribou past the channel, by sight.

Sea gulls sightings common.

About 7:00 am, the barge started back to Baker Lake.

#### 22 August 2009.

On the way back to Baker Lake saw mainly Caribou on the north side Channel.

Waterfowl and Sea Gulls common sightings.

Arrived about 10:30 in Baker Lake.

Stayed in Baker Lake, and his flight is scheduled to leave 2:30 to Chesterfield.

Reported verbally with Michael Haqpi at the Agnico-Eagle office in Baker Lake. From 9:30 to 11:00 am on 24<sup>th</sup> August. 2009.
