Re: Meadowbank Production Lease KVPL08D280 - Proposed Expansion of Meadowbank Airstrip

Agnico-Eagle Mines Limited – Meadowbank Division (AEM) is proposing to expand the Meadowbank airstrip by increasing the length and width in order to accommodate a Boeing 737 jet. The proposed airstrip expansion does not increase the footprint of the Project and is not a significant variation from the current Mine Plan. AEM requests the advice of the Kivalliq Inuit Association on whether or not an amendment to Production Lease KVPL08D280 may be required. AEM is currently seeking approval of the proposal from the Nunavut Impact Review Board, Nunavut Planning Commission, Nunavut Water Board and Department of Fisheries and Oceans.

Construction of the airstrip expansion is proposed for the third quarter of 2010. More details on the proposed work are included in the attached Project Proposal.
