## Hello Richard

According to our Type A water license (2AM-MEA0815), we are required to submit 4 plans within 90 days/3 months of license issuance. These plans are:

- Revised Incineration Management Plan (Part F, Item 10)
- Revised Landfill Design and Management Plan (Part F, Item 11)
- Revised Landfarm Design and Management Plan (Part F, Item 12)
- Operation and Maintenance Manual for the Sewage Treatment Plant (Part D, Item 19)

The first two plans (incinerator and landfill) have been completed and will be sent to you on Monday Oct 6 2008. The third plan (landfarm) has been revised and is undergoing internal review as of today; new figures are being produced for this plan. This plan should be completed and forwarded to you by the end of next week (Oct 10 2008).

The 'Operation and Maintenance Manual for the Sewage Treatment Plant' is in progress. As it is a new plan (not a revision to a former plan), it has taken a considerable amount of time for me to research the operational and maintenance procedures undertaken at the plant. Therefore, I am formally requesting a 30 day extension for the completion of this plan. While I don't expect to take an additional 30 days to complete the plan, I'd like to have a sufficient amount of time for internal review and comments.

Please advise if the Nunavut Water Board is agreeable to the extension.
