Please find the following information as a follow up to the Spill report submitted June 23rd 2016 by Agnico Eagle Meadowbank Division. This detailed report is submitted to the Inspector in compliance with the conditions under the Nunavut Water Board License 2AM-MEA1525, Part H, Item 8c.

Spill description

On June 23rd during operations at Vault pit, a hydraulic hose ruptured on Drill #4 causing oil to be spilled to the ground

There was no off site impacts or discharge to an receiving watercourse

Spill location: Northing 65'04'33" Easting 95'59'98"





Cause of Spill

Mechanical failure as the hydraulic hose ruptured on the drill

Remediation Actions

Operator of the drill stopped the equipment immediately to prevent further contamination. Absorbent pads were placed on the ground and a plastic 2ndary containment under the leak. Once the leak was repaired, absorbent pads were picked up and disposed of appropriately and oil collected in the 2ndary containment was placed in a sealed drum and brought to the HAZMAT area to be disposed of appropriately.
