Thank you for forwarding the October monitoring summary for the Meadowbank Project. Following a quick read of the results, the comment I would make is that the table reporting the spills would be more useful if there was a column for "Cause". In the NWT the report this and it has been helpful to see what has caused the (most frequently hydraulic hoses bursting!) and that informs mitigation/adaptive management as well as developing realistic expectations of problems that are associated with our climate.
