## Dear Minister:

Please find enclosed, Amendment No.1 to Licence 2AM-MEA0815, duly issued by the Nunavut Water Board (NWB). This amendment authorizes Agnico-Eagle Mines Limited (AEM), to carry out the proposed expansion and continued operation of the Marshalling Area Bulk Fuel Storage Facility. Reasons for Decision are included with the issued amendment, for your information.

Upon review of the application and submissions, the NWB determined that the amendment would not affect the use, flow or quality of waters or alter the term of the licence, and accordingly, under section 174(1) of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, the NWB determined that a public hearing was not required to amend the Type A Licence.

In accordance with section 56 of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, the proposed amendment requires your approval and as such, the NWB submits the attached Amendment for your consideration.
