## Re: Errata to Application for Amendment to the Meliadine Mine Type A Water Licence

Dear Mr. Dwyer,

On January 26, 2024, Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle) issued its application to amend Type A Water Licence 2AM-MEL1631 (the Water Licence Amendment Application). Within the documentation submitted, there were a few noted clerical errors (e.g., typos) which Agnico Eagle would like to provide correction via this Errata to provide greater clarity to reviewers. These minor clerical errors should not delay the process.

**Table 1: Water Licence Amendment Application Corrections**

The tailings quantity unit of measure is listed as 20.6 m³ which is a typo. The error was listed in the bulleted lists summarizing the amendment details. It is noted that the correct unit of measure is used in Table 1.2-1 of the Main Application Document and within the Waste Management Plan.	•	Section 1.1, page 2 of the Main Application Document Section 2.1, page 15 of the Main Application Document Block 9 of the Application Form Section 2.4, page 15 of the Interim Closure and Reclamation Plan (Appendix F-12 of the Application)	The correct unit of measure is 20.6 Mm <sup>3</sup> .
The text detailing the forecasted discharge to Meliadine Lake in the Water Management Plan incorrectly states 0 discharge to Meliadine Lake in 2025 onwards. It is noted that the correct discharge is described in the first paragraph of Section 4.3 of the Water Management Plan, and full details of the Water Balance Water Quality Model are provided in Appendix E of the same plan.	•	Section 4.3, page 38 of the Water Management Plan (Appendix F-21 of the Application)	The correct forecasted discharges to Meliadine Lake average 0.91 Mm³/year, with peak annual discharge of 1.98 Mm³ occurring in 2029 in response to an expanded mine footprint.
