The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Amendment of water license 2AM-MEL1631, to allow construction of works and activities originally found to be in conformity in 2011.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. The activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC, and a conformity determination was issued on [June 8, 2011] which still applies. In addition, the activities were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE NO.: 11MN034). This project proposal is exempt from the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NUPPAA) under section 235 of that Act. The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.
