Dear Larry Connell:

The enclosed guidelines are issued by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) for Agnico-Eagle Mines Ltd.'s (AEM; the Proponent) preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Meliadine Gold Mine project (NIRB File No. 11MN034). Pursuant to Section 12.5.2 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement, the Proponent is responsible to prepare an EIS in accordance with the guidelines issued by the NIRB. The EIS developed in accordance with these guidelines will serve as the basis for the NIRB's Review of the Project, and will enable the Board and interested parties to understand and assess the potential for Project-related ecosystemic and socio-economic effects.

Please be advised that the NIRB will require hard copies of the Proponent's future *draft* EIS submission to be sent to the following address:

As a NIRB – Nunavut Water Board (NWB) coordinated process was requested for the NIRB's Review of the Meliadine Gold Mine project and subsequent water licensing, the current EIS Guidelines include an Appendix which outlines the requirements of AEM's *Draft* water licence application, to be included with its future *draft* EIS submission. As such, the Proponent is required to submit hard copies of the future *draft* EIS submission to the following NWB addresses:

The NIRB respectfully requests that the Proponent review the enclosed guidelines and advise the Board of its anticipated date for submission of a *draft* EIS at its earliest convenience.

The Proponent is required to submit the aforementioned copies of the *draft* EIS to the NIRB and NWB concurrently or as close to the same date as possible to allow the Boards to co-ordinate their respective processes in alignment with the coordinated approach requested by AEM. The Proponent should note that next steps in the NIRB's Review process may not commence until both agencies have received copies as indicated. The Proponent is encouraged to follow up with the NIRB and NWB to ensure all copies of the *draft* EIS have been received as requested.

Please be advised that it is the Proponent's responsibility to supply authorities responsible for potentially authorizing this proposed Project with sufficient hard copies of the future *draft* EIS submission for review purposes. The NIRB will distribute correspondence to its public distribution list requesting that all parties which might require a hard copy of the future *draft* EIS supply the NIRB with mailing addresses and the required number of copies, which the NIRB will then forward to the Proponent.
