As part of its monitoring function required by the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement, the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) is responsible to conduct an annual site visit of Agnico Eagle Mines Limited's "Meliadine Gold Mine" project located northwest of Rankin Inlet. In transit to the Meliadine site, NIRB staff will be in Rankin Inlet on September 2, 2015 and are planning to host a public community information session to provide residents with updated information about the ongoing monitoring of the Meliadine Project.
