Notice is given that the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) has scheduled a Public Hearing in respect of Agnico Eagle Mines Limited's "Saline Effluent Discharge to Marine Environment, Rankin Inlet, Meliadine Gold Mine" Project Proposal, a proposed amendment to the approved Meliadine Gold Mine (NIRB File No. 11MN034). The Public Hearing is part of the Board's reconsideration of the terms and conditions of the Meliadine Project Certificate No. 006 under Article 12, Section 12.8.2 of the *Nunavut Agreement* and s. 112 of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*.
