Mines Limited's "Meliadine Gold Mine" Project, August 24 and 25, 2020

Dear Parties:

As part of its monitoring function, the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) will be in Rankin Inlet on August 24 and 25, 2020 to host Community Information Sessions regarding Agnico Eagle Mines Limited's Meliadine Gold Mine Project (NIRB File No. 11MN034) located approximately 25 kilometres northwest of Rankin Inlet. The recent changes to Public Health Orders that allow for the reopening of offices and the increase in group size for indoor gatherings allow the Board to preserve and protect the health of participants, while recognizing the importance of finding a way to continue to deliver on the NIRB's mandate and conduct thorough and timely assessments and maintain monitoring obligations even during this unprecedented and challenging time.
