A. BACKGROUND

On August 27, 2015 the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) provided notification to interested parties that Agnico Eagle Mines Limited Partnership (Agnico Eagle or the applicant) had completed submission of an application for a Type "A" water licence # 2AM-MEL---- for development work related to the mining of the Meliadine Gold Project.

Interested parties were asked to review the water licence application and provide technical comments by October 5, 2015.

On October 14-15, 2015 the NWB held a Technical Meeting and Pre-Hearing Conference in Rankin Inlet.

On November 10, 2015 the NWB distributed its Pre-Hearing Decision Report; this report contained all applicable upcoming submission dates for intervenors as well as the applicant for the final review stage of the licencing process. As well, the Pre-Hearing Decision Report contained a list of all outstanding commitments and applicable dates for the applicant attached to the Decision Report as Appendix D.

B. RESULTS OF REVIEW

On behalf of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada's (AANDC) Water Resources Division, comments and recommendations are provided for the NWB's consideration.

Recommendation: AANDC recommends that commitments 1-7 remain as stated and reserves the right to provide further comment and recommendation to each commitment in the above table upon reviewing the associated plans and/or reports.

Security

1) Comment: Since the Technical Meeting/Pre-Hearing Conference, INAC, AEM and the Kivallig Inuit Association (KIA) engaged in a teleconference to come to an agreement on the amount of security for the Meliadine project proposal. During the teleconference it was agreed by all parties that an amount of \$49,554,667 Million dollars would represent a sufficient quantum of security that could be recommended to the board.

In addition to this, INAC and KIA are working on a Security Management Agreement (SMA) to eliminate over bonding, whereby both parties would hold a 50-50 split of the total amount of security. There has been no formal agreement reached as of yet on this SMA however, INAC is confident an agreement can be reached and signed before the Public Hearing is held.

Recommendation: Since a total amount of security (49,554,667 Million) has been agreed upon between INAC, KIA and AEM, INAC recommends that the Financial Security to be held under the water licence for the proposed Meliadine project be set at the agreed amount (between INAC and KIA) that will be set out in the Security Management Agreement.
