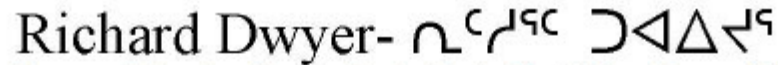
- On or before January 29, 2021 Agnico Eagle provides remaining information from commitments list required to be filed before the PH;

- On or before March 8, 2021 the Applicant provides their replies to the Intervenors' comments
- On or before March 15, 2021 the Intervenors file their final written submissions and presentations for the Public Hearing
- On or before March 22, 2021 the Applicant files their final written submission and presentations for the Public Hearing

In the week of March 29-April 2 the NWB conducts the **Public Hearing and Community Session in-person in Rankin Inlet**, closes the Public Hearing Record for the Amendment Application, and remits the matter to the NWB's decision-making Panel for their decision.
