Re: March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2023 Meliadine Water Licence Inspection Follow-Up

Mr. Amsel,

As requested, Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle) is providing an update on the efforts for areas noted in section 1.6 of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada's (CIRNAC) March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023, Meliadine Water Licence 2AM-MEL1631 inspection report.

As you know, during late June and July 2023, Agnico Eagle continued to assess and inventory various equipment and items at the exploration camp and laydown. As per the "Exploration Camp Inventory 2023" document reviewed with you on July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and provided to you on August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023, Agnico Eagle has identified items that are in use, being assessed for reuse or determined to be disposed of or removed from the site during the annual sealift, to the satisfaction of the Inspector.

The document outlines the action plan with applicable timeframes for each action item as per 1.6 of the inspection report. Additionally, Agnico Eagle will continue efforts through the "Sunday Boots in the Field Cleanup" and the annual "Million Dollar Cleanup" initiatives. Action items that are complete will be presented in the applicable Annual Reports.

As always, Agnico Eagle appreciates CIRNAC's review of the action plan, and we look forward to presenting the results of these efforts in future Annual Reports.
