	Lake and Meliadine River are not included as part of the
	AEMP. Regional hydrological monitoring is commonly
	incorporated into AEMPs to assess projects effects on
	flows, that can intern directly impact fish and fish
	habitat. The Amended Water Licence allows for a
	significantly increased volume of water use from
	Meliadine Lake, that has potential to effect flows
	downstream.
Recommendation	DFO recommends that the Agnico Eagle Mines Limited
	provide a explanation as to how water levels and flows
	in Meliadine Lake and Meliadine River will be
	monitored and managed to ensure fish and fish habitat
	are protected.
