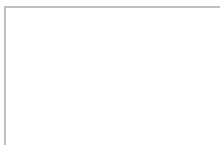
On behalf of the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KivIA) and Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC), Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle) is pleased to provide confirmation to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) that all three parties have mutually agreed on the security associated with the 2AM-MEL1631 Water Licence Amendment. The global security has been agreed at \$158,450,658.

With further discussion and agreement, all three parties agreed to dividing the global security amount into three tranches. The agreed breakdown of the tranches is provided in the attached Schedule C, to be amended to the Water Licence Amendment.

All three parties are comfortable to provide this confirmation at the Final Hearing September 11-12, 2024.
