BACKGROUND

On January 19, 2017, the Nunavut Water Board (Board or NWB) requested that interested parties review Agnico Eagle Mines Limited's (AEM) submission regarding final design and construction for sewage treatment plant as a requirement of Part D, Item 1 and 2 of the current Water Licence No. 2AM-MEL1631 for Meliadine Gold Mine project.

Interested parties were asked to provide comments by January 30, 2017.

RESULT OF REVIEW

Comment 1:

The provided document entitled 'Meliadine Sewage Treatment Plant' contains design of sewage treatment system for a maximum daily flow rate of 216 cubic meters. The

average Biological Oxygen Demand (BOD) in the influent has been reported to be 200-360 mg/L. The water quality parameters for raw sewage (chemical oxygen demand or COD, total suspended solids or TSS, nitrate, nitrite, pH, total phosphorus, ammonia, total kjeldahl nitrogen or NTK, fecal coliforms and total coliforms) and treated sewage (BOD, COD, TSS, nitrate, nitrite, pH, total phosphorus, ammonia, NTK, fecal coliforms and total coliforms) have not been mentioned in the design report.

Recommendation:

INAC recommends the licensee to mention the concentrations of water quality parameters for untreated sewage (influent) and treated sewage (effluent) in the provided report. The water quality parameters regarding sewage treatment plant are BOD, COD, TSS, nitrate, nitrite, pH, total phosphorus, ammonia, total kjeldahl nitrogen or NTK, fecal coliforms and total coliforms.
