

Recommendation Made by Interested Party:

The Kivalliq Inuit Association has no current concerns related to the impacts of:

- 1. The proposed water volumes from the waterbodies to be drained/dewatered.
- 2. Results of the non-potentially ARD generating (non-PAG) samples collected from Tiriganiaq 01, 01 expansion, 02 and SP4 waste rock and pit wall rock samples.

As the dewatering activities will result in fish habitat destruction, the KIA wishes to continue involvement in the habitat offsetting planning.

CIRNAC recommends that, at the start of the draining/dewatering activities, AEM should track and provide daily, monthly and annual records of water drained from each of the ponds designated for draining within the Meliadine mine infrastructure footprint (namely ponds, A40, B33, B33A, A9, A38, J6, J5, and J4).

Agnico Eagle's Response to Recommendation:

As per NWB Water Licence Schedule B Item 1h, Agnico Eagle will provide daily, monthly and annual records of water drained from each of the ponds designated for draining within the Meliadine mine infrastructure footprint (namely ponds, A40, B33, B33A, A9, A38, J6, J5, and J4).

Recommendation Made by Interested Party:

CIRNAC recommends that AEM:

- a) Provide a dewatering plan indicating mitigation measures against potential flooding concerns in respective recipient water bodies within the Meliadine mine infrastructure footprint as a result of the proposed pond draining activities;
- b) Clarify whether it intends to transfer all water volumes from the listed ponds into Meliadine Lake as permitted by the Water Licence or not;
- c) Provide information on the water transfer process and respective transfer destinations for each water body of interest designated for dewatering.

Agnico Eagle's Response to Recommendation:

Part a)

The details of the dewatering plan will be included in the Water Management Plan to be submitted as part of the 2021 annual report due March 31, 2022.

Part b)

Agnico Eagle confirms that it intends to transfer all water volumes from the listed ponds into Meliadine Lake as permitted by Water Licence Part I Item 9b.

Part c

Water from all ponds will be transferred to CP1 prior to treatment by the EWTP and discharge into Meliadine Lake. Details will be included in the Water Management Plan to be submitted as part of the 2021 annual report due March 31, 2022.
