- Primary – 15V 547673.11 m E, 6977021.63 m N
- Secondary – 15V 547397.91 m E, 6976968.56 m N

The sample station name is MEL-SR-17. Analytical results will be provided in the 2AM-MEL1631 monthly report along with the discharge location and corresponding discharge volume should the analytical results indicate compliance with Part D Item 18.

As per the quoted section AEM will need to indicate the intended sampling station number to be used and provide that notification to the NWB and myself.

Any discharges will need to be reflected in monthly and annual reporting.

As per Part E Item 3 the use of the waters for dust suppression is permitted, however this will need to be reflected in monthly and annual reporting and be inclusive of volumes indicated in Part E Item 1 & 2. Further as this water is from a site of operations it will need to be tested prior to being used for dust suppression as per Part D Item 18.

We would use the criteria as per Part D, Item 18 of the Licence (i.e. criteria for MEL-SR stations, as described in Table 2 of Schedule I: *Surface Runoff: runoff downstream of Construction areas at Meliadine Site and Itivia Site, Seeps in contact with the roads, earthworks and any Runoff and/or discharge from borrow pits and quarries*).

I confirm I meant the borrow pit and that there is no blasting occurring at this location.

Good afternoon Kyle,

As per part F Item 11 of the Nunavut Water Board Licence 2AM-MEL1631, Agnico Eagle Mines Limited informs you of the planned discharge of water from the Quarry B12 at KM 15 on the west side of the AWAR (Quarry Permit KVCA11Q01). Following snow melt, water has accumulated inside the quarry, which requires dewatering.

Water will only be discharged onto tundra (or a wooden pallet to prevent erosion) upon reception of results meeting the Licence criteria. Water will be discharged south of the quarry; the approximate UTM coordinates of the discharge location are 15V 547508.38 E, 6976968.10 N. The discharge of approximately 4,000 m³ of water is planned to commence on June 4th, 2023.

Agnico Eagle is also requesting the optional use of compliant water for dust suppression on the All-weather Access Road (AWAR).
