Re: <u>2AM MRY---- Public Hearing: Type "A" Water Licence Application by Baffinland</u> <u>Iron Mines Corporation for the Mary River Project</u>

Further to the Nunavut Water Board's (NWB or Board) January 25, 2013 Technical Meeting and Pre-hearing Conference Decision<sup>1</sup> (TC-PHC Decision) for Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation's (BIMC or Applicant) Type "A" Water Licence Application (Application) for the Mary River Project in which interested parties were invited to provide final written submissions by March 22, 2013, the NWB has received written submissions from five (5) intervening parties:

- Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC);
- Environment Canada (EC);
- Fisheries and Ocean Canada (DFO);
- Natural Resources Canada (NRCan); and
- The Qikiqtani Inuit Association (QIA).

Reflecting the Board's direction in the TC-PHC Decision, on April 5, 2013, the Applicant filed its final written submissions with the Board.

It should be noted that in keeping with Rule 12.4 of the NWB's general *Rules of Practice and Procedure for Public Hearings* (2005) that requires all written submissions to be filed with the

Board at least 15 days prior to the commencement of the Public Hearing and the deadlines for filing written submissions provided to the parties by the NWB in the TM/PHC Decision, the Board anticipates that there will be no additional final written submissions filed with the Board prior to the Mary River Project Public Hearing, scheduled for <u>April 23-25, 2013</u> in Pond Inlet, Nunavut.

In preparation for the Public Hearing, the NWB has attached the Agenda to this correspondence. The NWB recommends that prospective participants review their submissions and the relevant documents associated with the Application with the aim of identifying, during the Public Hearing, the issues or items in their submissions that have been resolved or remain outstanding and/or ongoing. The Applicant and each intervening party will be allotted 90 minutes and 60 minutes, respectively, for their PowerPoint presentations. The NWB has arranged for simultaneous English-to-Inuktitut or Inuktitut-to-English interpretation to ensure that all interested persons are able to fully participate in the hearing. Further, to provide community members with access to the information presented, intervening parties should make available for distribution during the Public Hearing, paper copies in English and Inuktitut of their presentations (50 copies in English and 50 copies in Inuktitut). To assist NWB in ensuring that adequate preparations are made to accommodate participants during the hearing, it is requested that all intervening parties provide the Board with the following information via email to licensing@nunavutwaterboard.org before April 18, 2013 (4 p.m. MST):

- 1. Confirmation of the number and names of the person(s) that will be representing each intervening party during the Public Hearing; and
- 2. Electronic copies (English and Inuktitut versions) of each PowerPoint presentation.
