Further to our recent correspondence on the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) conformity process we have some additional questions regarding the status of your applications to both the Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) and the Nunavut Water Board (NWB).

You will know from the NPC's past practice on the Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation Early Revenue Phase proposal in 2013 that the process usually followed by the NPC in these matters has agencies like the DFO and the NWB provide completed applications to the NPC as the basis for the conformity determination process.

Please advise when you expect your applications to those agencies will be completed. We will then be in a better position to inform you on the NPC conformity timelines and process.
