1. Introduction

1.1 Description and Overview

The Mary River Project is located on north Baffin Island, in the Nunavut Territory, in the Canadian arctic. One aspect of the project that is required is obtaining a Nunavut Water Board (NWB) Type A Water Licence to operate. In order to do this, a Water Licence application needs to be completed and submitted to the Board so that they can exercise their powers under the Nunavut Waters Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act (NWNSTRA or Act) and the Northwest Territories Water Regulations (NTWR or Regulations).
