Dear Derek Chubb and the Mary River Distribution List:

The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) has completed scoping of the Mary River Project (the Project). In addition to soliciting input from government departments, Inuit Organizations, and other interested agencies regarding the *draft* scope of the Project, the NIRB has an obligation to engage members of those communities potentially affected by the Project, and to consider any comments or concerns raised during community consultations.

From March 28<sup>th</sup> to May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2009, the NIRB facilitated public scoping meetings, open houses and other presentations in the communities of Pond Inlet, Arctic Bay, Resolute, Grise Fiord, Igloolik, Hall Beach, Coral Harbour, Cape Dorset, Kimmirut, Clyde River and Iqaluit. Those communities were determined by the Board to be potentially impacted by the Project or affected by any potential amendment to the North Baffin Regional Land Use Plan required by this project proposal.
