Notice is given that the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) will be holding a Public Hearing in respect of the NIRB's Reconsideration of the Mary River Project Certificate [No. 005] pursuant to Section 12.8.2 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement. The Hearing is being held to assess the potential ecosystemic and socio-economic impacts of the Early Revenue Phase proposal associated with the Mary River project (NIRB File No. 08MN053) as proposed by Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation.
