Re: <u>Draft Amended Project Certificate for Baffinland Iron Mines Corp.'s Mary River Project – Early Revenue Phase Proposal</u>

Dear Parties:

On May 8, 2014 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) issued correspondence to parties which requested that, by May 14, 2014, regulatory agencies and interested parties confirm their planned attendance for an upcoming project certificate workshop associated with Baffinland Iron Mines Corp.'s Mary River Project (NIRB File No. 08MN053), to be held via teleconference, May 21, 2014. The NIRB further encouraged parties to consider those terms and conditions from the March 17, 2014 Public Hearing Report which they expected to implement through their respective licences, permits or approvals and, any terms and conditions which, in their view, might require clarification prior to issuance of a Project Certificate.

NEXT STEPS

As previously committed, the NIRB has enclosed a *draft* Project Certificate for review, which has been amended to include new and revised terms and conditions as set out in the Board's Public Hearing Report for the Early Revenue Phase proposal, and as have since been varied by the Minister of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development in his April 28, 2014 correspondence to the NIRB. The NIRB expects that the *draft* Project Certificate as enclosed will form the basis of discussions for the workshop, as set out in the agenda attached as **Appendix A**. Please be advised that for the ease of parties' review, the NIRB has formatted the draft amended Project Certificate in such a manner as to highlight the new and revised terms and conditions for discussion purposes. The Board looks forward to ensuring discussions provide the clarification required for the production of the most effective amended Project Certificate possible.
