Following the second Technical Meeting Baffinland met with the QIA and representatives from the Hamlets of Pond Inlet and Igloolik and the Mittimatalik Hunters and Trappers Organization to discuss the incorporation of the Tusqtavut Study into the Phase 2 assessment, and Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit (IQ) more generally. The outcome of this meeting and subsequent working sessions was that Baffinland will supply an updated Culture, Resource, and Land Use (CRLU) Assessment, and engage Inuit communities in the significance determination process. It was also understood that this would have substantive

implications for other deliverables, including the Food Security Assessment and IQ Collection Framework, and that their submission would be tied to the results of the CRLU Assessment.

At present Baffinland has verification sessions for the Community Risk Assessment and Crossing Selection Workshops scheduled for the first half of September that will contribute to the CRLU Assessment, and that related documents will be submitted to the QIA and NIRB on or before September 16th. Following additional IQ collection activities with communities, currently planned for the week of October 14th, a CRLU Addendum will be submitted to the QIA and NIRB prior to the Public Hearing.

Baffinland notes that the Regional Caribou Monitoring Memorandum of Understanding is still outstanding, however, negotiations are ongoing between Baffinland and the Government of Nunavut and both parties will endeavor to provide a copy of the finalized document before the Public Hearing.

Baffinland appreciates the continued efforts of the NIRB and Interveners to ensure an efficient and timely review process. We trust the responses provided will satisfy the intent of technical requests from Interveners. Baffinland reiterates its commitment to identifying and resolving issues as early as possible, and will make every effort to create opportunities for this to occur.
