EC comments on the proposed agenda:

According to the NWB's December 19 letter "The purpose of the Technical Meeting (TM) is to informally discuss and resolve any outstanding technical matters associated with the Application" but the proposed agenda indicates that the technical meeting is to be formally structured around intervenor presentations rather than around technical topics. EC is concerned that the overlapping mandates of the intervenors will result in an inefficient meeting in which topics are "re-discussed" after each intervenor presentation. EC is of the opinion that productive informal conversations are unlikely to be sparked by intervenor presentations but would flow naturally from topic specific discussions. With that in mind we encourage the board to structure the meeting around the issues that were identified in intervenor submissions.
