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BAFFINLAND IRON MINES CORPORATION'S MARY RIVER PROJECT, 2018 ANNUAL REPORT FOR OPERATIONS- QIKIQTANI INUIT ASSOCIATION **REVIEW**

The Qikiqtani Inuit Association (QIA) submits this letter to Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation (Baffinland) and the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) under Section 6.4 of the Commercial Production Lease No. Q13C301 (the Lease)¹ and Water Licence 2AM-MRY1325.2 The QIA acknowledges receipt of the 2018 Annual Report3 (the Report). QIA recognizes the effort required to complete the submission. Particularly, QIA notes the effort required to update the reporting format to meet the mutually agreed upon layout in the Lease Operations Guide.

QIA carried out a review of the Report and has provided a list of reasonable requests in the attached **Table 1**. As per Section 5.2. a) viii of the Lease to be responded to by September 30, 2019. If Baffinland does not agree or cannot confirm the timeline requested, please respond with why the timeline cannot be met and what Baffinland would consider an acceptable adjusted timeline.

During its review, QIA noted that contrary to the Lease Operations Guide and Section 6.4 c) of the Lease, As-Built and Construction Summary Reports for some

However, Baffinland does not provide possible explanation for this particular trend.	Baffinland please provide insight on the high occurrence of sewage spills at MSC. Additionally, list any steps currently being taken to reduce the risk/occurrence of spills of treated and untreated sewage from the MSC Lift Stations.
7.	52	Monitoring	On September 4, 2018, effluent from the Oily water treatment system (OWTS) which was treating water from MS-HWB-7, was shown to have a lead concentration exceeding discharge criteria. Baffinland may not have reported the quantity of water discharged in Table 6.1 as required by the Water Licence.	Can Baffinland confirm the volume of water exceeding Water Licence criteria which was discharged into the receiving environment?
8.	79-80	Inbound and Outbound Shipments to and from the Project	Table 2.2 and 2.3 in the Appendix include summaries of items being shipped to and from the Project. In the "Equipment/material items" column of these tables, Baffinland has grouped a broad variety of items under the designation of "Equipment and other materials". Moreover, it has not specified ownership of these, stating "Baffinland and third party" in the "Owner" column.	Baffinland provide a revised listing separating out "Equipment", "Mobile Equipment", "Other Materials". Moreover, Baffinland specify whether these items are owned by Baffinland or third-party companies.
