RE: Notice to the Parties NWB Request For Comment on the Timing and Process for the Annual Security Review for 2015-2016 under Part C and Schedule C of Type "A" Water Licence 2AM-MRY1325 Mary River Project

Mr. Côté,

The Qikiqtani Inuit Association (QIA) is writing this letter to you in response to the NWB's letter of October 7th, 2014.

In the NWB's letter it has been requested that QIA provide information to support the Annual Security Review (ASR) for 2015-16 in relation to 2AM-MRY1325, and, to provide comments related to any preferences QIA has relative to the process and scheduling for the 2015-16 ASR.

Specifically, the NWB has requested that QIA supply information with respect to Schedule C: Conditions Applying to Security, Item 2, sub items c-e. These have each been responded to below:

c. the total of any equivalent financial security being held by the Minister and/or the Qikiqtani Inuit Association outside the Licence;

QIA can confirm it is currently in possession of a letter of credit for a total amount of \$39,793,000. This amount is held consistent with the requirements of Article 9 of Commercial Lease No.: Q13C301. QIA has previously shared Article 9 of Q13C301 with the NWB as part of the 2014-15 ASR process. Additionally, attached to this letter is a copy of the most recent amendment to the LOC held by QIA. The amended LOC represents the amount that was agreed to between QIA and the proponent in conjunction with the 2014-15 ASR process.

d. information that supports the increase, maintenance or reduction of the total financial security under the Licence; and

QIA will be able to provide such information in the context of filing its comments under the 2015-16 ASR process. It is QIA's understanding that the proponent will file a 2015-16 Work Plan consistent with the requirements of Q13C301 no later than November 1st, 2014, following which QIA will initiate its assessment of security.

QIA does not anticipate filing any other information prior to conducting its review of the 2015-16 Work Plan.

e. any other information necessary to support the request of the parties for the Board to issue further directions under Part C with respect to the amount of security to be furnished and maintained under the Licence.

QIA does not anticipate filing any other information prior to conducting its review of the 2015-16 Work Plan.

With respect to the proposed process for the 2015-16 ASR, consistent with the 2014-15 ASR process QIA's primary intention is to fulfill the requirements of Q13C301 which stipulates the following:

- 1. Proponent's submission of a Work Plan, on/before November 1st (see Q13C301, 9.2 (b))
- QIA filing of a security review with the proponent, on/before December 31st (see Q13C301, 9.2 (c))
- Proponent's posting of security adjustments with QIA, on/before January 31st (see Q13C301, 9.2 (d))

Consistent with last year's ASR, QIA's internal review and decision making processes related to the 2015-16 Work Plan are scheduled to conclude on December 18th, 2014. QIA can commit to filing such materials with both the proponent and the NWB on this date.
