Hello,

QIA is not in support of this extension request for the following reasons:

1. The dates of the ASR were already amended once. Those amendments being made at the request of AANDC.
2. QIA has altered organization plans to accommodate the revised dates. These adjustments include allocating time to review and develop responses prior to the scheduled ASR teleconference.
3. All parties require and deserve time to prepare for ASR events in a manner that will reduce outstanding issues and

therefore allow the NWB to come to more precise determinations.

4. Upon QIA request a meeting with AANDC and the proponent was held on November 20th. During this meeting the timelines associated with the ASR were raised. At no point was the possibly or need for an extension requested.

5. QIA has allocated extended hours to the completion of its own 2016 ASR submission, including interactions with the NWB, AANDC and the proponent. Had more time been allocated to the 2016 ASR submission process QIA would have certainly prepared differently.

6. QIA has consistently advocated for longer review times in the ASR and on each occasion these requests were not supported by AANDC, whereby AANDC stated the timelines as defined are appropriate.

7. QIA believes the current extension request presented by AANDC is yet another example for why the ASR process and the decisions rendered by NWB ought to be respected. This point is elaborated upon more extensively in QIA's ASR submission.

Attached to this message is QIA 2016 ASR filing, provided to both the proponent and the NWB in advance of the ASR teleconference scheduled for Dec.17th and filed in accordance with the Dec.3rd, 2015 deadline established by the NWB and agreed upon by all parties.
