Process for Mary River Project – Process Update and Draft Agenda

## **Dear Parties:**

This correspondence provides follow up direction supplementing the Nunavut Water Board's (NWB or Board) December 5, 2017 correspondence regarding additional guidance and a revised process schedule for the 2017 – 2018 Annual Security Review (ASR) Process for the Mary River Project. The NWB notes that to date the Board has received Interveners' submissions from the Qikiqtani Inuit Association (QIA). The submissions of Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) are expected to be received by the NWB on February 9, 2018.

Copies of the QIA submissions were provided to Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation (BIMC or Licensee) on February 2, 2018. Recognizing that the INAC submission has not yet been filed with the Board, BIMC will be given an opportunity to provide a separate response to INAC's submission by February 13, 2018. Copies of BIMC's 2018 Workplan, Interveners' submissions, as well as all other documents related to the current and previous ASR processes are accessible through the NWB's ftp site at the following link:
