The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt March 26, 2024, of the Waste Rock Facility Quality Assurance & Quality Control Monitoring Plan. This latest version is new and integrates comments received from both QIA and CIRNAC on draft components of this plan during the 2024 Annual Security Review Process.

The Nunavut Water Board would advise parties that while the updated plan shall reflect discussion and recommendations related to the 2024 ASR Process, the review and potential approval of the plan will likely be after finalizing the 2024 ASR given the timelines. The Board would like to note that the same plan will be part of the annual report submission.
