CIRNAC has only one concern regarding the timing of the ASR and the ongoing amendment application for the Type A license. By delaying the ASR to January 15, will that then form the basis for the security assessment required for the renewal application? In short, CIRNAC's question to the Board is, will these two processes now be run concurrently?

The ASR and associated ICRP which has been an outstanding item from the ASR processes for several years will need to be reviewed and a revised security estimate determined prior to the approval of a new license.
